

Location, Location, Location


35 miles inland from the



Whereas, the **Port of Victoria** and the **Port of Houston Authority** are interested in promoting an intramodal service between the two ports; and,

Whereas, the **Port of Victoria** and the **Port of Houston Authority** are committed to the efficient and cost effective distribution of cargo throughout the region; and,

Whereas, the **Port of Victoria** and the **Port of Houston Authority** are dedicated to the improvement of the environment, through the reduction of emissions associated with container truck traffic and the congestion caused by them; and,

Whereas, the **Port of Victoria** and the **Port of Houston Authority** will show that cooperation between large, deep draft ports and smaller shallow draft ports can produce economic and operational benefits for both; and,


Whereas, it is proposed that both ports will conduct programs and activities to mutually benefit each other and to forge a close working relationship,



Signed and made effective this 28th day of February, 2005.




