2011-14**MEMORANDUM FOR NAVIGATION INTERESTS**

SUBJECT: Forecast of Dredging and Marine Construction

SABINE NECHES WATERWAY- SABINE PASS CHANNEL, IN JEFFERSON COUNTY, TEXAS, AND CAMERON PERISH, LOUISIANA

The Dredge “Linda LaQuay” (King Fisher Marine Service CP) is dredging the Sabine Pass Channel. Dredge material is being disposed across the channel into Placement Area No. 5 C.

SABINE NECHES WATERWAY- LOWER AND MIDDLE REACHES NECHES RIVER, IN JEFFERSON AND ORANGE COUNTIES, TEXAS

The Dredge “Marion” (Pine Bluff Dredging Co.) is dredging the Sabine River “Section B” with material being disposed into the Old River Beneficial Site.

HOUSTON GALVESTON NAVIGATION CHANNEL, TEXAS – PLACEMENT AREAS NOS. 14 AND 15 EXPANSION WITH DREDGING BAYPORT TO MORGAN POINT, IN HARRIS AND CHAMBERS COUNTIES, TEXAS

Dredge RS Weeks (Weeks Marine) is replaced by the dredge “E.W. Ellefson (Weeks Marine). Maintenance dredging is continuing in Houston Ship Channel from vicinity Beacon 76 to Morgans Point with material being placed in Placement Area 15 located at Atkinson Island.

CEDAR BAYOU AND ANAHUAC CHANNELS IN CHAMBERS COUNTY, TEXAS

Dredge Jonathan King Boyd (RLB Contracting) will commence dredging Cedar Bayou Channel on/about 14/15 July. Material will be placed into Placement Area 16 on Atkinson Island.

CHOCOLATE BAYOU, TEXAS CHOCOLATE BAYOU CHANNEL, DREDGING AND REPAIRS OF THE PA’S 4A, 1A AND REHAB OF PA 4.

Goodloe Marine, Inc. dredge “Mike” continues to dredge Chocolate Bayou Channel upstream of the FM 2004 Bridge. Goodloe Marine is scheduled to complete dredging of Chocolate Bayou by 08 Sept 2011. Submerged, pontoon and shore line are being used to place material in PA 4.

MATAGORDA SHIP CHANNEL, TEXAS- MATAGORDA PENINSULA TO POINT COMFORT IN MATAGORDA AND CALHOUN COUNTIES, TEXAS

The Cutterhead Dredge “John” (King Fisher Marine Service LP) is dredging operations in the Matagorda Ship Channel Alcoa Basin at approximately mile marker 22. 2,. Dredge Material will be placed on Open Water Placement Area No. 19. Dredging operations will be completed in early part of September, 2011.

GULF INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY, TEXAS - TURNSTAKE ISLAND TO LIVE OAK POINT, IN CALHUN, ARANSAS, AND SAN PATRICIO COUNTY, TEXAS

The Cutterhead Dredge "Leonard Fisher" (King Fisher Marine Service LP) is dredging operations in the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway at approximately mile marker 502 and moving on an Easterly direction. Dredge Material will be placed on Upland Beneficial Use Site (B.U.S.) D-2. Dredging operations will be completed in early part of September, 2011.

- » *Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.*
- » *Dredging operations are continuous, 24 hrs, 7 days, unless otherwise noted.*
- » *Dredging operations will continue through the month unless otherwise indicated.*
- » *Dredges monitor channel 13 and/or 16 on marine VHF radio, respective dredges should be contacted for coordination of passing and movement near operations.*
